- **Horse Island**, the **private retreat** of Christina and Trevor Kennedy, tucked away in the estuary of Tuross Lake. To the west, the Great Dividing Range and to the east, the South Pacific. Christina has created a **stunning garden of predominantly Australian native plants** that complement **the beauty of the surrounding landscape, the homestead and cottages**. What has been created is a truly impressive achievement and your visit to Horse Island will undoubtedly be a **highlight of your time in the Eurobodalla**.

We are **grateful to Christina** for inviting us to **visit this private garden**.

We travel by coach from and to the Eurobodalla Regional Botanic Garden.

A good level of mobility is required for this tour.

Morning tea is included.

Early booking is essential as **numbers are strictly limited**.

The day continues back at the Garden with:

- **Behind the scenes at our Garden**. This tour will commence with **lunch in the Garden** followed by a guided walk around **our Nursery and Propagation area**, the **heritage listed Wallace Herbarium**, the **Seed Bank**, the new **Naturescape Display Gardens** and our **Visitor Centre**. A good level of mobility will ensure you get the most from this tour. You will have the opportunity to get “up close and personal” with the staff, Friends and volunteers, and find **what makes the partnership so successful**. You’ll have the opportunity to ask questions about the **successful collaboration between Friends and Council that’s resulted in securing and spending over \$3.5m of grants and contributions over the last 4 years**.

Batemans Bay is an easy and scenic 4-hour drive south of Sydney and less than 2 hours east of Canberra. Regular flights from Sydney and Melbourne to Moruya Airport (25 minutes south of Batemans Bay). Car hire is available.

We have each **chosen our favourite spots** for you to **experience** and **enjoy** our lovely part of New South Wales, a region we are very fortunate to live in.

- Take the **coastal road** from **Batemans Bay to Moruya**, an easy half hour drive, passing by **small communities, wonderful beaches and rivers**, finally arriving at the small township of Moruya. Take this drive on a **Tuesday afternoon** and drop into our Award-winning **SAGE Farmers Markets**, Riverside Park at 3.00pm. Local growers provide quality, sustainable local food and produce.

- **Burrewarra Point** at Guerrilla Bay is an easy walk, through mature banksia forests and casuarina groves with views of the South Coast and the hinterland. This area **escaped the Black Summer Fires** of 2019/20, becoming a favourite feeding ground for birds and animals. The track runs **along the cliff edges** to a **viewing platform** offering spectacular views, an ideal spot to do some **whale watching as they head north** on their migration to warmer waters.
- **Hire a kayak** from the **Boat Shed at Mossy Point** on the Tomago River, and paddle up stream passing by mangroves, around bends and under bridges. **Stingrays hang around boat ramps** waiting for fish frames to be thrown to them by fishermen cleaning their catch. Afterwards **enjoy a coffee and cake at the Boat Shed**, a lovely way to spend the morning.


- **Bingi Bingi Point** is situated between Congo and Tuross within the Eurobodalla National Park. **Spectacular views and granite rock formations** follow the coast. **Birdwatching** can be enjoyed year-round. The **Bingi Bingi Dreaming Track** runs from Congo to Tuross passing by Bingi Bingi Point. A fabulous 14km walking track, walk the full track or just a small part of it following the coastline. Bird and animal life is abundant along this track. **Lunch at the Tuross Boat Shed**, dining on **local fish n chips**, overlooking the lake. Sitting on the jetty at water level is always fun, watching the boating and marine life pass by.

- The **Bodalla Dairy Shed** is a 45-minute drive south from Batemans Bay. A family run dairy shed showcasing **unique bush tucker flavours in their local cheeses**. Have a snack, and then an opportunity to take home their locally produced tasty cheeses. Or lunch at <https://downwarddogcafe.com.au/> Enjoy strolling around Bodalla's shops, including **Hippie Sticks** – famed for its tie-dye everything, and Australian made incense. <https://www.bodalladairy.com.au>
- Our South Coast is famous for its oysters. **The Oyster Shed, a farm gate** located on the **Clyde River** in **Batemans Bay** is essential for all lovers of oysters. Oysters can be sold either opened for you to **enjoy on the banks of the river** or unopened for you to takeaway. Oysters for lunch – decadent and delicious.

- **Holmes Lookout** is found high on the ridge line **offering scenic views** over the Clyde River as it winds its way towards the Pacific Ocean. You can see Batemans Bay to the southeast and glimpses of the Budawang Ranges to the northwest. **Picnic tables and barbecue facilities** are available, making it a lovely way to spend a few hours **relaxing and enjoying nature and the view**. You could continue on to:
- **Nelligen**, a small village located on the Clyde River, along the Kings Highway just a 10-minute drive from Batemans Bay. **Surrounded by forests** and with the **pristine waters** of the Clyde River, Nelligen is an exciting and **historic** place to explore, and enjoy a picnic or ice-cream on the grassy riverbank. **It's so easy to feel a million miles from anywhere.**
