## Eurobodalla Regional Botanic Garden (ERBG) 2022 Photographic Competition

Friends of Eurobodalla Regional Botanic Garden in partnership with the Eurobodalla Shire Council invite photographers to enter the 2022 competition. Entry to the competition is free.

All entrants have a chance to win cash prizes and have their images selected for exhibition and inclusion in the 2023 Botanic Garden Calendar.

The competition will award an overall prize in the junior section (under 18) and the senior section. The public will have the opportunity to vote on their favourite image, which will win the People's Choice Award.

All images included in the 2022 exhibition will be available for sale to the public.

### SECTIONS

- **Senior Section** overall winner will receive \$300 for best in exhibit. \$100 prizes may be awarded for First Place in Each Category.
- **Junior Section** overall winner will receive \$200.00 for best in exhibit. \$100 prizes may be awarded for First Place in Each Category.
- **People's Choice Award** winner will receive \$250.00.

### How to Enter

**RULES ARE DIFFERENT TO PREVIOUS YEARS SO PLEASE READ THEM CAREFULLY**

- All entries will be accepted in digital format only.
- Pick up and fill out the Photo Consent Form available on line [www.erbg.org.au](http://www.erbg.org.au) or from the Garden Visitors Centre
- **Deliver your clearly labelled USB Stick together with the completed Photo Consent Form to the Gardens Visitors Centre no later than 4pm on 30th Oct 2022. USB sticks can be picked up at end of exhibition.**

- Selected entries will be exhibited at the Garden between 18<sup>th</sup> November and 4<sup>th</sup> December 2022.
- Overall and Category winners will be announced at the opening of the exhibition and Calendar Launch on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The People's Choice Award winner will be announced at the close of the exhibit.

### RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

To be eligible for exhibition and judging all entries must comply with the following rules & conditions –

1. **A maximum of 8 high resolution entries overall, they can be in one or over all the Categories.**
2. Entries can be Portrait or Landscape
3. **No printed images are required.**
4. All Images are to have been taken over the last 12 months and within the Eurobodalla Regional Botanic Garden
5. Entries submitted to previous ERBG Photographic competitions are not eligible for entry
6. All entrants must sign the ERBG Photo Consent form
7. Competition organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or move an entry to another category
8. The decision of the Judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into
9. Should the entries in any category fall below the standard required by organisers and judges, the organisers reserve the right not to award prizes.
10. Competition organisers will limit the number of entries exhibited.
11. Competition organisers reserve the right to select the final entries for the 2023 Botanic Garden Calendar
12. Competition organisers will select, print and mount in A3 all entries eligible for exhibition. All exhibited prints will remain the property of ERBG.
13. A condition of entry is that submission of images gives automatic consent to the ERBG to use those images for exhibition, advertising or fundraising purposes.
